

T1 Friendly Foodie Privacy Policy

This document outlines the policy regarding the collection, use and disclosure of Personal Information received from users of the T1 Friendly Foodie diabetic food blog (<http://t1friendlyfoodie.com/>), in accordance with requirements under The Privacy Act 1988 in Australia.

The provision of personal information by users of the T1 Friendly Foodie Site is at the voluntary discretion of the party using the Site. Personal Information is used only for providing, improving and maintaining the Site. By using the Site, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy.

Information Collection and Use

While using this Site, you may be asked to provide T1 Friendly Foodie with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you. Users of the Site are given the option to subscribe to regular notifications of new posts when they are published. It is the discretion of each individual user of the Site, as to whether they wish to register for this service. Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to, your name and email address.

All users of the Site have the option to unsubscribe from this service at any time via the Subscription section of the blog Site. This will be effective automatically once the user unsubscribes.

Log Data

Like many site operators, information that your browser sends whenever you visit our Site is collected. This Log Data may include information such as your computer's Internet Protocol ("IP") address, browser type, browser version, the pages of our Site that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages and other statistics.

In addition, third party services such as Google Analytics that collect, monitor and analyse this Site, may be used. A third party service such as Google AdSense may be used to assist with the management of advertising on the Site.

Communications

Personal Information may be used by T1 Friendly Foodie to contact you with newsletters, marketing or promotional materials and other information where relevant.

Cookies

Cookies are files with small amount of data, which may include an anonymous unique identifier. Cookies are sent to your browser from a web site and stored on your computer's hard drive.

Like many sites, "cookies" are used by this Site to collect information. You can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, if you do not accept cookies, you may not be able to use some portions of this Site.

Security

The security of your Personal Information is important, but please remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, is 100% secure. While T1 Friendly Foodie strives to use commercially acceptable means to protect your Personal Information, it is not possible to guarantee its absolute security and we encourage all users to update their personal security on their electronic devices.
